

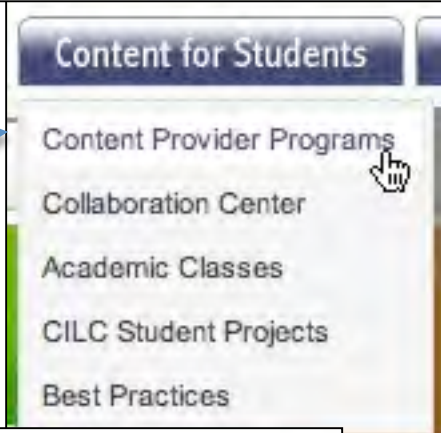

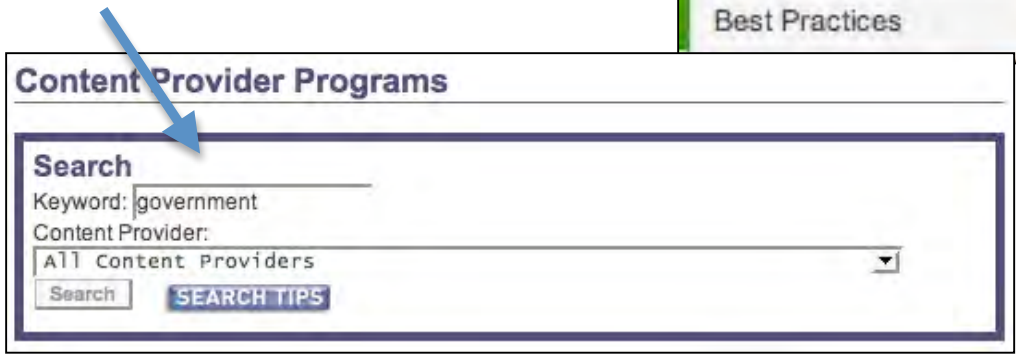


Click on **Content for Students**

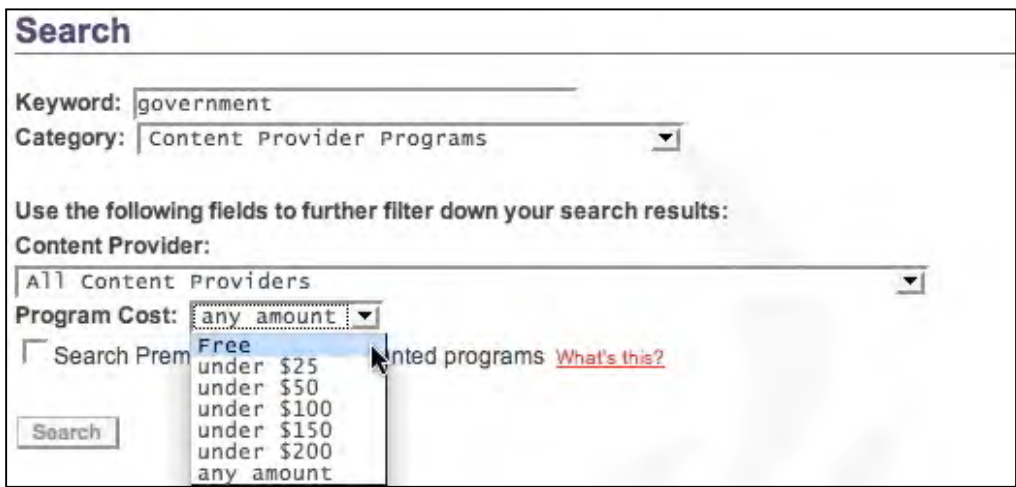
Scroll to **Content Provider Programs**


